Research Scholarships for young researchers

CONDITIONS

The Hardt Foundation for the Study of Classical Antiquity, in pursuit of its ambition to promote the study and awareness of the culture and civilization of Greco-Roman antiquity, offers young researchers the possibility to apply for research awards financing stays of between two weeks and two months.

The awards cover the cost of residence at the Hardt Foundation (single room, full board) as well as a portion of travel costs. The grants of the Hardt Foundation do not cover the months of July and August.

The areas of research supported are Greek and Latin Language and Literature, Ancient History, Ancient Philosophy and Ancient Law. The aim of the research is the publication of articles, books or other written contributions.

Eligibility:

- up to 35 years of age maximum at the moment of application
- PhD candidate (2nd year, at least) or post-doctoral researcher

Candidates are requested to submit an application addressed to the Foundation's Director, Mr. Pierre Ducrey, at the address given below, including the following documents:

- ◇ a curriculum vitæ
- ◇ a cover letter
- ◇ a research proposal
- ◇ two letters of recommendation from University Professors
- ◇ copy or scan of the passport or the identity card
- ◇ for applicants who are not University Professors (Full, Associate or Assistant Professor), a description of their career plans

The application may be sent by email (in PDF format) or by postal mail. Hard copies of applications cannot be returned. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

The closing dates for the receipt of applications and letters of referees are as follows:

- 30th November for stays requested between early February and the end of June
- 30th April for stays requested between early September and the end of November.

Decisions on awards will be made the week following the closing dates. All applicants will be notified of the results as soon as possible.

At the end of their stay, beneficiaries of awards will be required to submit a brief report on their research. They are requested to mention the support of the Hardt Foundation in any publication arising from work undertaken during their tenure of the award.
